Q: What were the strengths of this course and/or this instructor?

- Instructor is extremely knowledgeable in the field and is great at explaining concepts clearly. Extremely engaging and informative lecturer. Excellent slides and challenges.
- Don't take Kaan for granted: he is a great lecturer and is one of the most proactive instructors I've witnessed (he grades like a madman).
- Very knowledgeable on all topics
- Kaan is an amazing professor and incredibly knowledgeable and passionate about cybersecurity. This class was extremely challenging, but also incredibly rewarding. I learned so much from him and from his assignments and also had the most fun ever!
- He's super knowledgeable, having authored many papers in the area. He also knows how to transmit knowledge to people. This is the first time in my life I've actually learned something from an exam, for instance.
- CY3740 was an indispensable course that gave me a well-structured and fundamental understanding of system security. He is funny and entertaining in class and always ready to answer questions for his students. He always finds a way to hold the student's attention. In other classes, I would be distracted, but never in Kaan's class.

Q: What could the instructor do to make this course better?

- 1 Challenge 5 was a bit annoying because the relevant slides about request smuggling gave a different impression about how to do request smuggling than what was needed on challenge 5.
- 2 Sometimes certain lectures drag on, but maybe I just have particular interests
- 3 Maybe more TAs and office hours if the class is large again. The TAs did their best, but I felt bad that they were always staying an hour or two after office hours were supposed to end. It was great that the instruction team created the two extra office hours slots in the beginning of the course, and they were very helpful, but it would have been more helpful to have more TAs.
- 4 Nothing it was good
- 5 More office hours. Perhaps not all TAs at the same time, but have each TA hold their own 2 hour office hour block twice a week. TAs will work the same amount of time and office hour availability will greatly increase.
- 6 I think more optional challenges would be cool. I know he mentioned something regarding return oriented programming which would be a cool challenge.
- 7 More in class demos would be helpful
- 8 Kaan's experience and intense wisdom makes him a bit unapproachable. My one regret from our class time was being unable to work up the courage to talk to him and ask questions during office hours, which is upsetting as I think it would have improved my ability to learn.

- 12 Challenges could be made a little less open-ended. The lectures are definitely helpful for solving them, but sometimes I felt unprepared going into a challenge with the theory I had. Perhaps more in-class examples could help. Additionally, I found the bonus challenges a little awkwardly situated. They're described as being a good way to earn back points if you missed some elsewhere, but because they're generally harder to complete than the challenges themselves (namely, no hints), they might not help you.

It's almost impossible to actually fully complete the challenges otherwise

Q: What could the instructor do to make this course better?

- 15 Give a better study plan. I wasted a lot of time studying things that were not on the test.
Also - don't trick the class. It's mean.
- 16 I think one would be to better align the course material and the challenges. I feel that at times it becomes too easy to get hyperfocused on the challenges that you forget the material since they can take extensive periods of time.
- 17 not much. I loved every second of this class. The exams are hard to study for but that just seems to be from the course really covering every part of systems security
- 18 Nothing, really
- 19 More clear hints for certain homework. Hints are structured to sort-of sidestep the correct answer, and to properly use them we needed to analyze what they don't say, rather than what they do say.

Q: Please expand on the instructor's strengths and/or areas for improvement in facilitating inclusive learning.

- 1 Keep up the good work. Lectures were all informative and helpful. Challenges were fun.
- 2 You're good
- 3 The instructor is experienced in the security field so his lectures are informative. He's not a dry lecturer, has a sense of humor, and also cares about students. I found him kind of intimidating in the beginning but it was probably my anxiety talking, he was very helpful to me when I had questions.

Regarding inclusive learning, the instructor was aware that the teaching staff had no non-cis male representation and encouraged TA applications from everyone at the end of the course. I never felt that being female or LGBT affected my learning in this course.
